## Brouilly



Grape variety: Gamay



Viticulture: Sandy soil on a granite arena. The plot is located in the town of Quincié en Beaujolais, it faces Mont Brouilly. Facing south-east at an altitude of 500m, it is one of the highest plots in the appellation. Cultivated and harvested for the first time in 2017. It has just been bought by the estate.





Winemaking: Manual harvest. 80% destemming, 12 days vatting. Tuns aging for 9 months.



Winetasting: Ruby red color.

Intense nose with aromas of black fruit, spicy notes, with a hint of cinnamon. Powerful and supple on the palate with notes of red fruit and raspberry. The tannins are silky and give a nice length on the finish.



**Food and wine:** Veal rice, Game birds, Dried goat cheese.

Aging potentiel: 5 to 8 years.
